Student/Early Career Researcher Bursary

&

AARG Crisis-affected Nations Bursary Terms

1. The Bursary will be solely for the purposes of supporting attendance at the forthcoming AARG conference.
2. The Bursary includes the conference registration only; it does not include the conference dinner or field trip which must be booked separately.
3. The Bursary recipient agrees to give a talk or poster presentation of their work at the forthcoming AARG conference.
4. The Bursary recipient may claim any amount up to a maximum set out by the AARG Treasurer, e.g. 300 € in 2025, and they are expected to source the best value options e.g. by sharing accommodation / transport with other attendees.
5. The items the Bursary recipient claims support for should not also be funded by any other organisation as doing so would be fraudulent use of the bursary.
6. The money will be paid on receipt of an invoice to AARG Treasurer which must have:
 - a. the amount to be claimed in €
 - b. copies of receipts confirming the expenditure
 - c. the full name and bank details of the account holder (IBAN /SWIFT)
7. The invoice can be processed at any time from the acceptance of the bursary but must be received within one month of the end of the conference.
8. AARG reserves the right to withhold payment if invoices are insufficient in detail or submitted without receipts.
